

IDCN publishes Annual Review 2014

Network continues worldwide expansion with new locations

Vevey, 17 June 2015 – The International Dual Career Network (IDCN) has released its Annual Report for 2014 today. The IDCN can look back on a very successful year: Four new networks launched in Los Angeles, New York, Dubai and Basel, bringing the total number up to ten. To date, over 160 spouses have found a job with the support of IDCN and more than 1900 spouses are involved in the network around the globe.

In the past year, IDCN continued to professionalised its internal structures by forming an executive board with members from eight companies to manage and evolve the network at a global level. Furthermore, IDCN is pleased that Technip, ABB, Mondelez, Colgate Palmolive, International Flavors & Fragrances Inc. and Kimberly-Clark Corporation joined as global members in 2014.

Another key success was the launch of the IDCN website idcn.info. This was made possible through donations from the IDCN Executive Board members.

The Executive Board would like to recognize the hard work and contribution of 130+ partner volunteers. Without their enthusiasm and commitment, IDCN would not exist in current format today.

In 2015, the expansion of the International Dual Career Network will continue its expansion with a new location in Brussels as well as into the Asia Pacific region with network launches in Hong Kong, Beijing, and exploratory initiatives for Shanghai, Singapore and Chicago. New global members confirmed as of 2015 include Total and Danone.
