The International Dual Career Network (IDCN) is a network of multi-national corporates that help mobile employees' partners find jobs and integrate into new locations. Originally founded in 2011 by Nestlé, Phillip Morris International, Ernst & Young (now: EY) and the Vaud Chamber of Commerce in the Lake Geneva Region, it expanded globally only one year later and is now present in twelve different locations in Europe, the Americas and the Middle East. To further strengthen the position of IDCN in Asia, a new network launch is planned for Singapore in 2016.
